freed Zacchaeus and Matthew from being
enslaved by money; the adulteress and
Magdalene from seeking happiness only in
created things; made Peter weep after his
betrayal, and assured Paradise to the
repentant thief. Let us hear, as if addressed to
each one of us, the words that you spoke to
the Samaritan woman: “If you knew the gift
of God!”

You are the visible face of the invisible Father, of the God who manifests his power above all by forgiveness and mercy: let the Church be your visible face in the world, its Lord risen and glorified. 1. Prayer of a Cluttered Mind

2. O Jesus, crucified God, remember our pain. As you experience the pain and suffering of this world, we also in this moment suffer. Lord, examine us and supply your Spirit in our time of need. Supply our daily need. We rely on you. As you called out, "Abba! Why have you forsaken me" we recognize your lament. We now cry out to you in the same spirit, "Lord, see us." Protect our hearts by supplying your Spirit as our comfort in times of need. He alone is our comfort. You alone are our shelter. [FAB]
